

## **Child Exploitation (CE) Concerns**

#### **Warning Signs**

- · Sudden changes in behaviour, mood or health
- Going missing
- Increased drug/alcohol use
- Multiple or secretive phones





#### **Reporting Concerns**

### 1. Not open to Children's Services

- Complete Single Contact
  Form + Vulnerability
  Checklist send to MACH.
- MACH screens and involves Complex Safeguarding Team.

### 2. Open to Children's Services

- Social Worker refers via CE Vulnerability Checklist Form.
- Complex Safeguarding Team decides on CE meeting or consultation.



### 3. Child Looked After (placed by another LA)

- Notify Police via Philomena Protocol.
- Risks shared at MACE.

### Review Meetings (by Complex Safeguarding Team)

Low concern – every 12 weeks

Medium - every 8 weeks

High - every 4 weeks



# MACE (Multi-Agency Child Exploitation)

Monthly meetings with police, social care, health, education & other partners to:

- Identify trends, hotspots & perpetrators
- Share information across agencies
- Agree prevention, disruption & safeguarding actions
