

HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS PROGRAMME

Twelve session voluntary course aimed at individuals who are causing harm. The group setting encourages people to share their own behaviours, preventing negative ones' resurfacing.

PARTNER PROGRAMME

Seven session course running alongside the Healthy Relationship programme supporting the individual to understand the direction of change for their partner/ex-partner so they can work together to bring about positive changes in their relationship.

CHILDREN MATTER PROGRAMME

For parents who have successfully completed the Healthy Relationship/partner programme and want to explore how conflict impacts on children and how to avoid it in the future to build a harmonious family life.
